Do you know what God wants you to do? He wants you to obey His commandments. That means He wants you to listen to your parents and teachers, and not steal or lie or be mean to other kids.

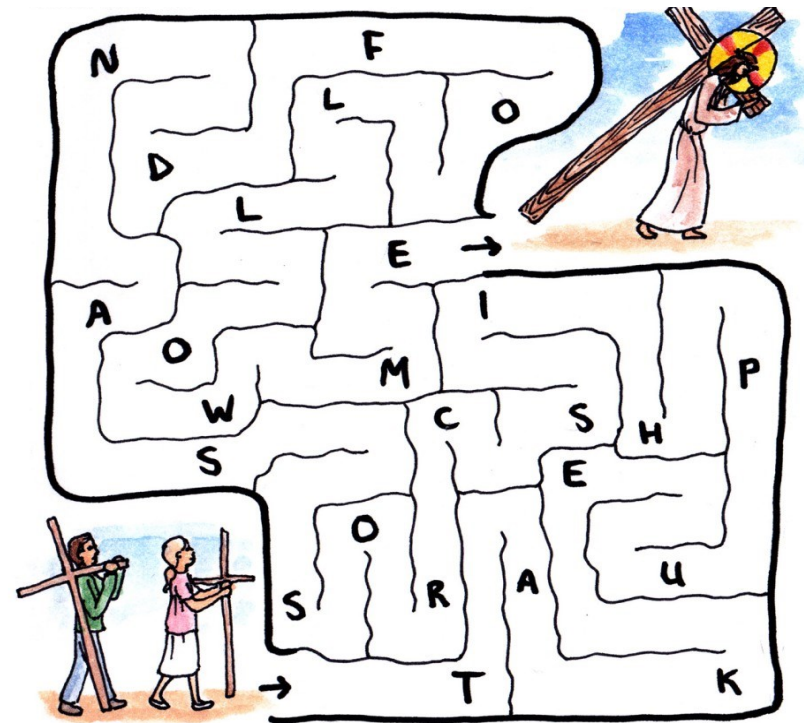


You can also show your faith by doing good works, like being nice to other people.

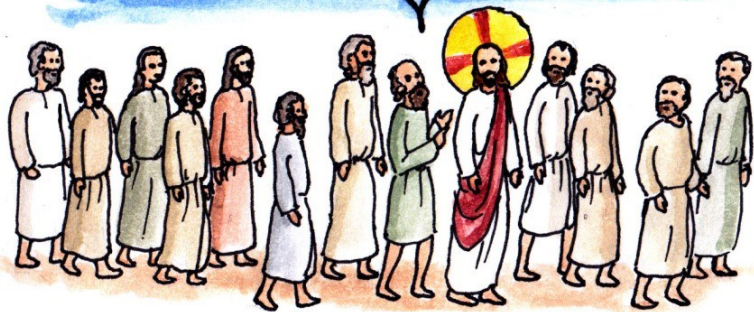

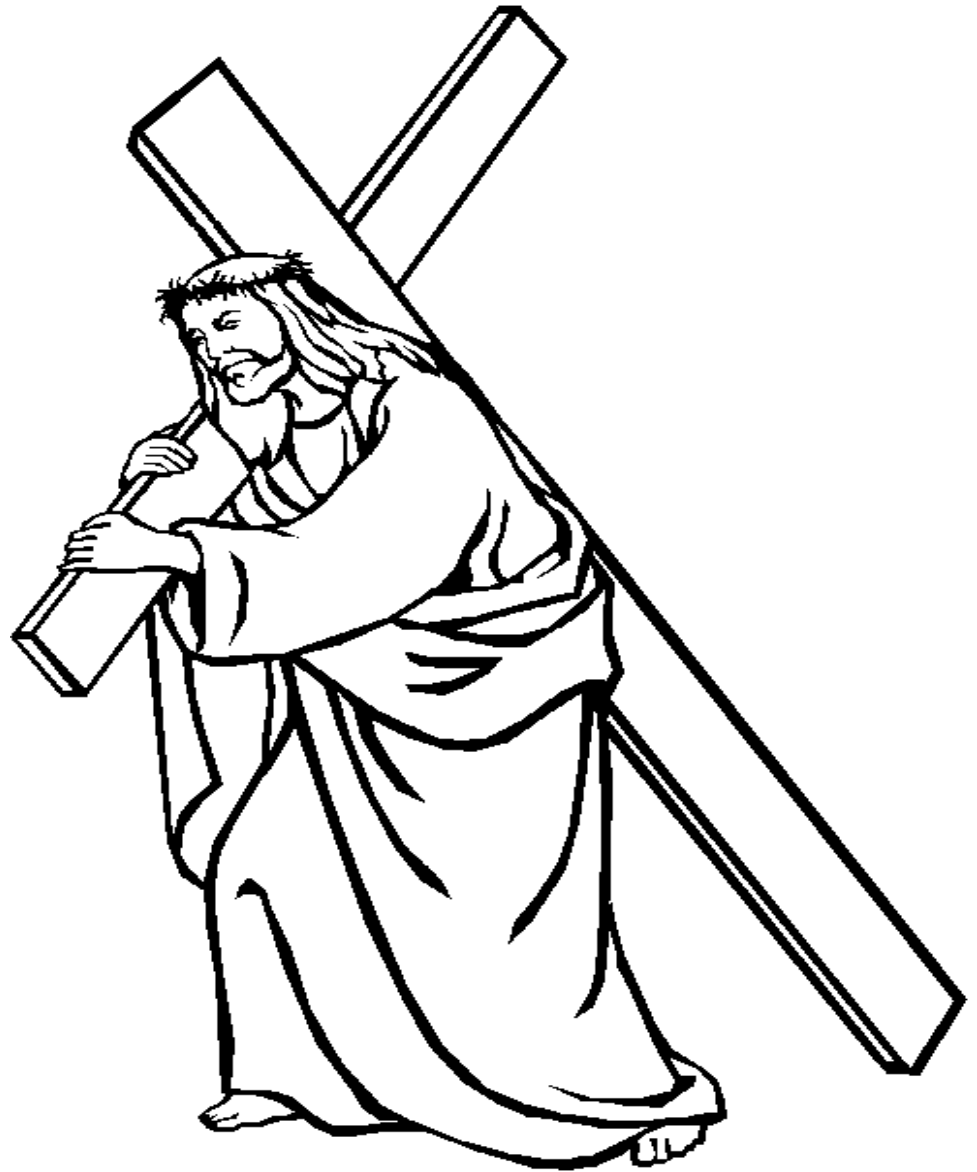
