Mark 10:2-12



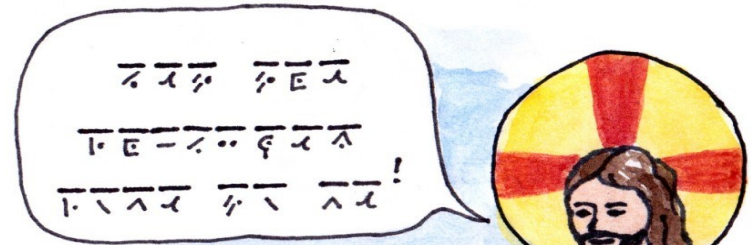
In today's Gospel reading Jesus was telling the people about God's idea of marriage.

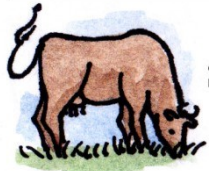

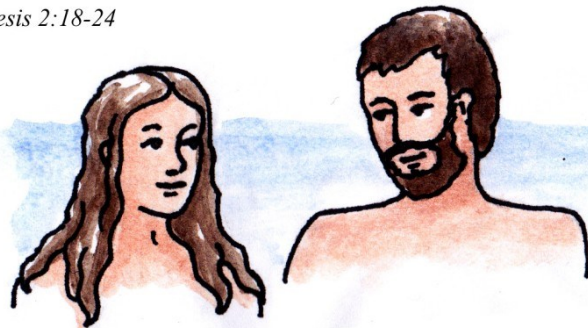
So the Lord God cast a deep _____
